Doors open at 6pm, shoot starts at 7pm, & shoot ends at 9:30.

Each shoot will consist of 14 grocery rounds, including three meat prizes per round, and 1 round for a larger meat item(turkey, ham, etc.)

Rules: This is an open setup shoot, no bow restrictions. Shoot what you bring!

This is similar to a turkey shoot, but with a bow and the top third of shooters closest to the center of the X per round, will win prizes. Size of arrow does not matter as it will be measured from the center of the hole.

These shoots will benefit 7 year old Reese Burdette of Mercersburg, PA who was badly burned in a house fire on Memorial Day. She was burned over 30% of her body with major damage to her lungs. She is still at Johns Hopkins in their burn unit. She has been brought out of her induced coma and continues to improve, but still has a long recovery ahead of her. These shoots will benefit Reese and her family to help with medical and travel expenses.
