April 8, 2025

Meeting called to order by President Bill Clough with Pledge of Allegiance and roll call of officers.

Two board members of the Cumberland Valley Breast Cancer Awareness Anita Glunt and Linda Martin gave a presentation about their group. They are willing to help with the Archery group when they have their grocery shoots next year. A check for \$1,500 was presented to CVBCA .

Archery- beginning April 14 they will be holding 3D archery shoots. The cost is \$5 per shooter. They will continue until May 19th. May continue on Thursday nights if there enough interest and approval from the BOD.

Trap- they had a shoot with Carlisle and won. They held the money shoot on April 5th. The cost per case to order targets is \$15.25.

Calls from the public about wild life problems are to be made to the Pa. Game Commission not us.

47 new members were voted in tonight. There will be 45 proposed new members at the May meeting and the remainder in June.

Ticket sales for the June drawing are starting to come in. So far there is \$6,000 in sales. Extra tickets can be obtained every Monday at the trap building or at the monthly meetings. Make sure you can read the phone number and name on any tickets you sell.

No reports from Black Powder or Groundhog committees.

Night Predator shoots- they had 7 shooters at the last shoot. There was \$42 profit.

On March 15th there were 7 signed up for the Basics of Pistol Shooting Course but only 2 showed up. They both passed the course and the written exam.

The pistol class for the 29th of March was canceled.

Old business- A decision of what beers we want for the June drawing needs to be made. We used 27.5 kegs last year and will have 30 kegs this year. The beers decided on are Yingling, Coors light, Landshark, Miller Light and one other. There will be 12 taps, 4 on truck and 8 on wagon. There will be two barrels of some kind maybe birch beer?

A member asked if it would be possible to have an Ice cream truck at the drawing. Some one will be checking to see if we can.

A deposit of \$5000.00 has been made on the tents.

Darrell is requesting \$100 to buy new dippers and tubs for the beans. He is also requesting \$400, \$200 for each of the beer tenders.

Andy- the seminar of April 9th Personal Protection Plan has been changed to April 16th.

The pistol course for the 19th of April will be rescheduled. The Non-Lethal Protection Options, Use of Pepper spray scheduled for April 16th will be changed to April 23rd from 12pm to 2pm and again at 5pm to 7pm.

The Aftermath of a Self defense Incident scheduled for April 23 will be rescheduled to either May 21st or 28th. Date to be announced later.

There is a Range Safety Officer course scheduled to run from the 6th through the 9th of May from 6:30 each evening. Let him know if there is any interest from the various shooting committees. There are 20 positions available on a first come and first served basis. Please see him as soon as you can.

The Trappers Association School that was held here last year had 92 attendees. The school will be held in Mt. Holly this year. They will be holding a trappers show at the Shippensburg Fair Grounds this year.

There will be a Tut wrapping on April 16th at 6pm. There will be several more over the next few months.

The berm work is finished. 50/50 for tonight was \$145.
