NRA—A Ladies Basic Pistol Shooting Course was held last last month had 8 signed but only 5 came to shoot. All passed the written test and shooting qualification. There are more courses scheduled this month.

Old business—Darrell volunteered to organize the June drawing for 2026. He has a schedule of what to do and who to contact. Tom is Co-chairman. Darrell stated that he had over ordered in the past and is working on that.

There was a profit of \$58,000 from the gambling. There was a total of 71 bowls at the June drawing, 22 king tuts, 19 red white and blue, 6 lock n load, 15 gun bowls and 9 ass kickers.

Also the targets were leaning against the posts and are not safe. The targets need to be secured to the ground or on a frame. Steel targets are not to be used on the 25, 50 and 100 yard ranges. They can be used on the 200 to 800 ranges only.
