Black powder committee- no report.

Groundhog committee—the account total as of the August shoot was \$1,867.92, they had income from the shoot of \$345 and paid out \$173. Leaving a balance of \$2,039.92.

Steel Gong shoots-- has shoots scheduled for Thursday September 11<sup>th</sup> at 5pm and on September 13<sup>th</sup> at 1pm. He is requesting dates to hold his night predator shoots starting on November 7<sup>th</sup>. Sent to board of directors for approval.
